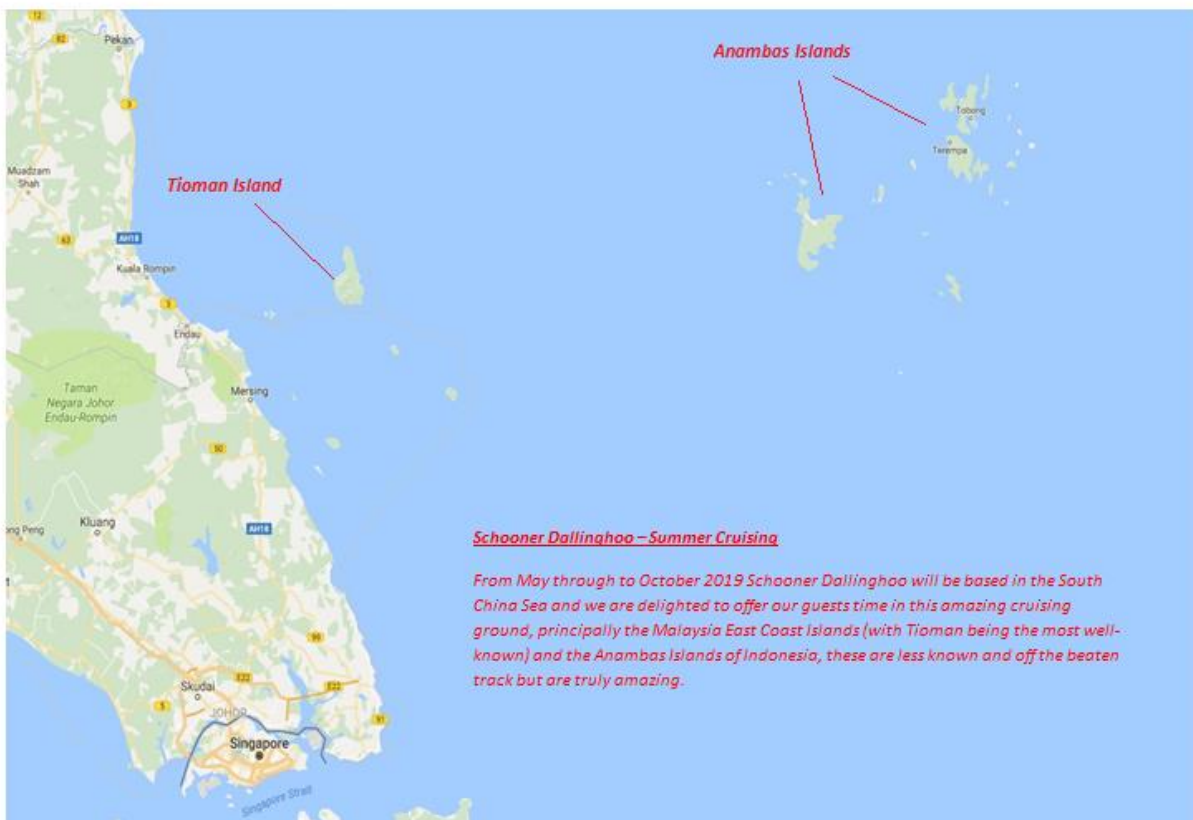
## 8-DAY / 7-NIGHT ITINERARY 2 – ANAMBAS



Anambas has a lot to offer. The pristine Anambas islands are a true tropical paradise, still largely undiscovered. Here you can step back in time, swim in warm blue seas or azure lagoons and view underwater scenery unparalleled in Asia. Cruising through the Anambas, you'll come across the occasional island village. The few inhabitants warmly welcome visitors with smiling faces and kindness.

Explorers who are curious to visit this paradise region do not have to travel to the end of the world. An easy starting place is the cosmopolitan travel hub of Singapore. From there, take a 45 minute ferry ride from Singapore's Changi Airport to Batam island, take a cab to the airport (15 minutes) and a 12:30, 65 minute flight, to Jemaja in the Anambas, where our captain will meet you for transfers to the yacht anchored in a picturesque lagoon nearby

Below is a sample itinerary for a 7 nights in the Anambas cruise which can be adjusted to suit guest requirements and duration:-





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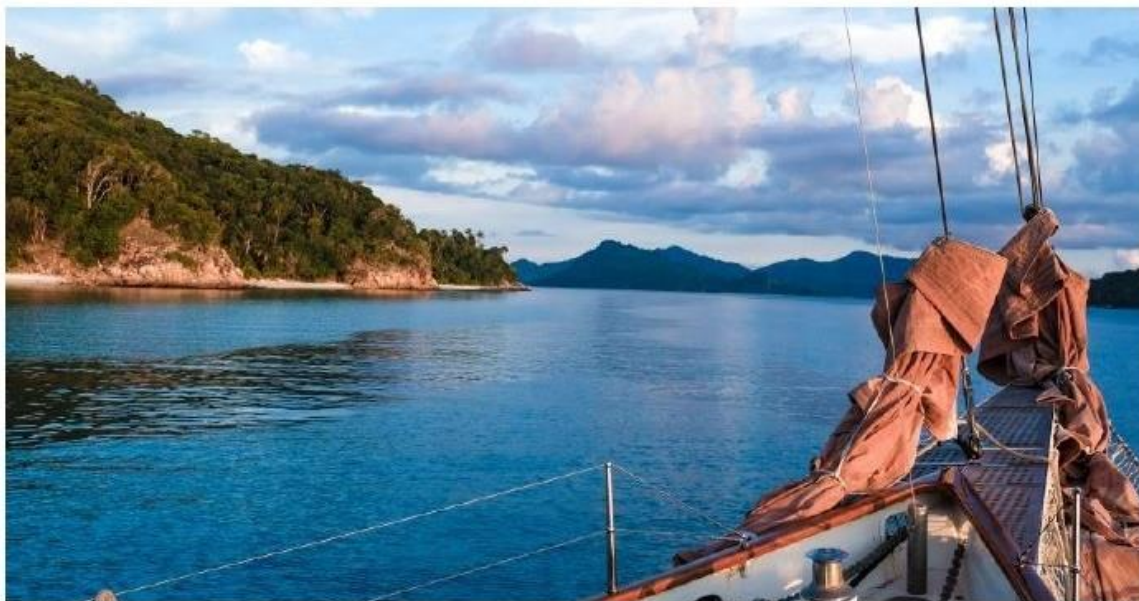


### DAY1: ARRIVE TO JEMAJA ISLAND (Letung airport Anambas)

Arrival in Jemaja at 13:40 after a short 65 minute flight from Batam Island. You will be met by the captain at the airport for a short taxi transfer to Letung, the village surrounded by aquamarine lagoons where the Dallinghoo is anchored. You will arrive on board at approximately 2:30 PM at which time we will serve a light lunch and prepare to sail to our first overnight anchorage on Pulau Mubur at one of our favourites, the 3 wise monkeys anchorage, on sand with beautiful coral reefs, teeming with aquatic life close by.

### DAY2: PULAU TELAGA

As the sun rises, awaken to clear blue skies and the first morning swim before breakfast and our departure to The beautiful lagoons of Telaga Island swimming snorkelling beach coming and kayaks are the order of the day





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### DAY3: PULAU AIRABU

A pleasant three-hour sail brings you to Pulau Airabu, another equally stunning, azure-colored lagoon. With a little luck, you may receive an escort from a playful pod of dolphins. With a little more luck, you might catch a fish for a delicious seafood dinner. The local fishermen know how to conserve their resources and no trawling nets are allowed; just the simple line and hook are used. Local delicacies include Tongkol (little tuna), Kerisi and Kerapu (grouper).

At Airabu is home to beaches, mangrove forests and coral reefs to explore in every direction; it's very likely there will not be another yacht in sight.

### DAY4: LUBANG TAMBAN

Enjoy an early morning sail with the northeast wind to your next destination: the island group of Lubang Tamban. The island group is largely uninhabited and surrounded by the clearest water you've ever seen. Walk on the white-sand beach, snorkel among beautiful corals or get coconuts straight from the trees and feel like a modern-day Robinson Crusoe.





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### DAY 5: TAREMPA, Siantan Island

Tarempa is in the heart of the Anambas; it is the capital as well as the administrative center. There are many small shops, a bakery and a market offering a wide range of goods. Walking through this clean, friendly town is accompanied by waves and hellos. You'll be met with an openness and generosity that is humbling. If you're up for a ride around the town, rent a moped or "ojek," as they're called in Anambas.

Dine on board or enjoy a local dinner with delicious fresh seafood at one of the lively restaurants in town. It's highly recommended to try local delicacies, such as nasi dagang, roti rendang, smokey tongkol, or the popular mie Tarempa (spicy fried noodles with fish and egg). Now and then you might catch a local cultural event such as a dance, kite-flying or a local wedding.

### DAY 6: TENGILLING ISLAND

With a wonderfully sheltered coves. You'll want to spend at least one night at Pulau Tengilling Lagoon with beautiful coral reefs near breaking the surface of the lagoon and great area for exploring by kayak or catching a fish dinner — a true gem with fine white-sand beaches and a simple bamboo resort on shore. The following day you'll cruise to Jemaja Island





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#### DAY7: JEMAJA ISLAND (Padang Melang beach)

After breakfast, you will set course to Padang Melang, which has the longest white-sand beach in the Anambas. Explore a small, colorful village and venture beyond to shimmering rice fields and waterfalls.

#### DAY8: JEMAJA ISLAND & Return Flight To Batam Island

A last leisurely morning and a final swim then after an early lunch depart Letung airport, Jemaja Island, your flight will be approximately 70 minutes for Batam Island and catch the ferry back to Singapore.

The Anambas islands are an amazing, authentic place with kind and generous people living at a blissfully unhurried pace. If you like to go off the beaten track, prefer active holidays and idyllic, secluded lagoons, then Anambas is the place for you!
