

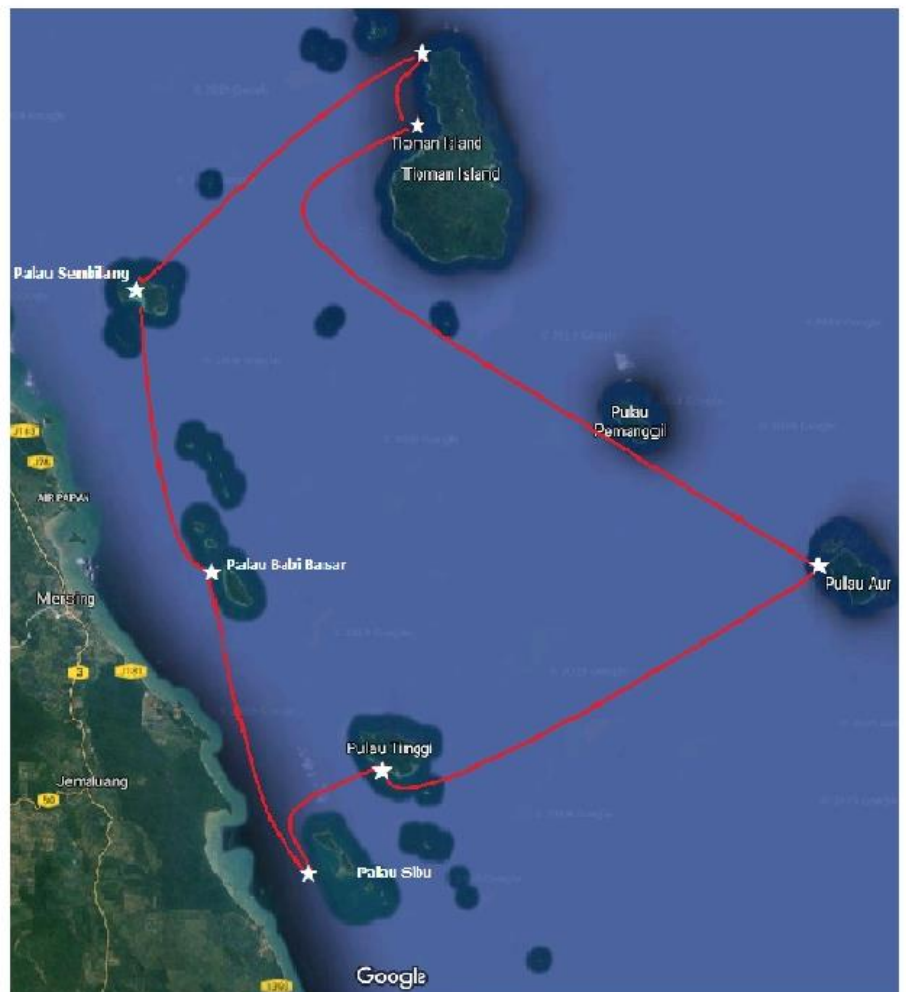

7 DAY / 8 NIGHT ITINERARY MALAYSIAN EAST COAST ISLANDS



This cruise starts and finishes on Palau Sibul situated in the Johor Marine National Park, a short speed boat ride from the mainland at Tanjung Leman which is a 1½ hour taxi ride from Singapore. Singapore is the major regional hub and retains the allure of the Orient and the tastes of the East in a glittering setting of skyscrapers and polished pavements. Here you will be able to wine and dine in the finest Asia has to offer and pamper yourself in the region's premier shopping destination before embarking on a cruise for a tropical getaway in the idyllic Tioman islands. Surrounding are dozens of small, beautiful islands such as Aur, Pemanggil, Sibul, Tinggi, Besar and Dayang.

Tioman itself, the paradise setting of the 1958 film "Bali Hai", is best known for its coral reefs and magnificent geography of steep hills, covered by thick virgin jungle, rising up to 3,500 feet! each day typically includes swimming, snorkelling, kayaking, beach-combing, or diving for scuba enthusiasts. On longer passages lie back, sunbathe and enjoy the amazing scenery. The best weather for cruising this area is between July and October.





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DAY 1 JOHOR TO PALAU SIBU

Take the short ferry ride from Singapore to Johor where you will clear immigration and you will be met by your transport for the 1 hour 30 minute drive to Tanjung Lemau. Here you will be met by the Dallinghoo crew and taken the short boat ride to where Dallinghoo will be waiting at anchor at Pulau Sibiu. Embarkation aboard Dallinghoo in the afternoon, and enjoy refreshments and the afternoon relaxing at anchor before your dinner and first night on board.



DAY 2: PALAU TINGGI

After breakfast weigh anchor and sail the short distance to Pulau Tinggi, an easy 7nm trip for your first day and the another beautiful anchorage for lunch and a day relaxing. Pulau Tinggi which gets its name from a hill rising 2,000 feet above sea level ("tinggi" is Malay for "high"). The island is painted green by the lush tropical forest, rich with rattan, timber and other valuable plants. The surrounding waters teem with exotic marine life and beautiful underwater flora fringing the coral reefs, providing a breathtaking underwater panorama for divers and snorkelers. The island is also blessed with natural fresh water and a sheltered harbour, making it a popular stopover point for trading ships in the past. The locals believe that Malay's most famous hero, Hang Tuah, stopped here on one of his journeys and that his spirit still guards the island.



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DAY 3; PULAU TINGGI & PULAU AUR

After breakfast depart for Pulau Tinggi for the 4 hour sail to Pulau Dayan and Pulau Aur. In the narrow channel separating these twin islands is a peaceful anchorage in a natural harbour fringed by empty beaches. The main settlement is Kampong Teluk Berhala with no roads or vehicles and, not surprisingly, everyone seems to be related to each other. The island waters are so clear that even without getting wet one can observe manta rays, dolphins and huge quantities of marine life at close quarters. For scuba divers there is a chance to dive with whale sharks, hover around immense coral gardens and walls, or dive on ominous and hulking shipwrecks.



DAY 4: PULAU TIOMAN

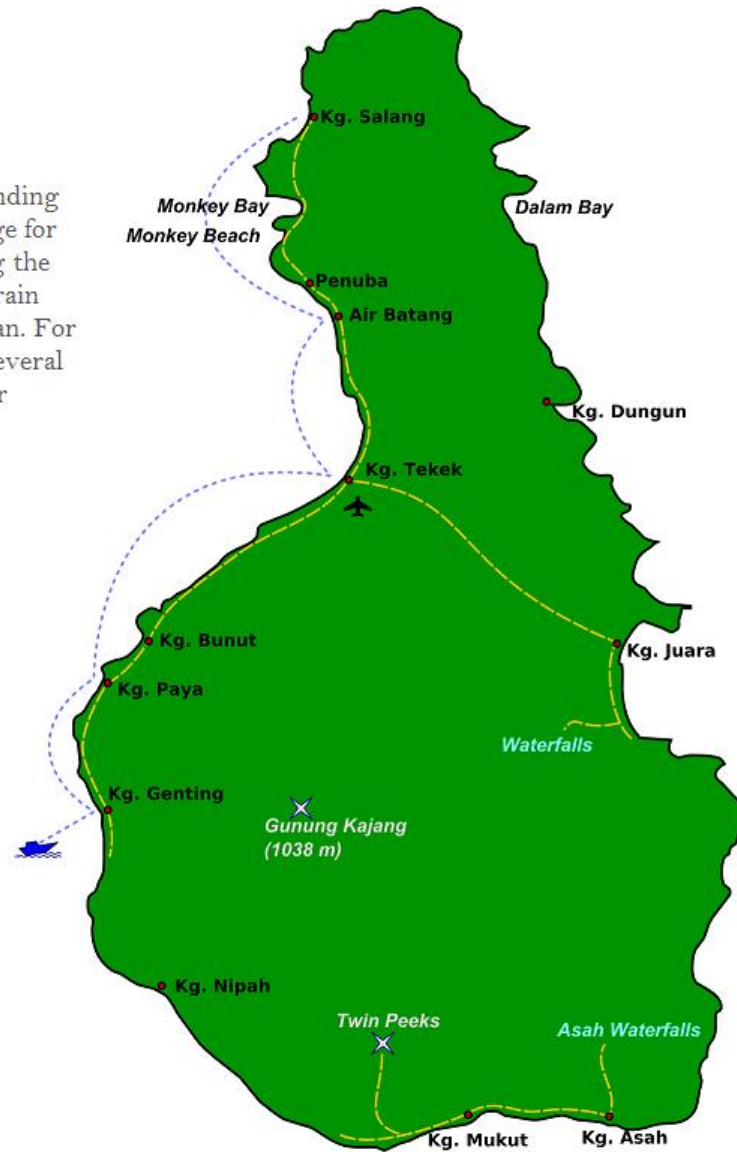
An early dawn departure from Pulau Aur for the 5 hour sail to Pulau Tioman. At the coral fringed Pulau Tioman there are opportunities to trek through the jungle and to swim beneath waterfalls. Golfers can take the opportunity to play a round at the Tioman island 18-hole links course. Tioman is reputed to be in the top ten world's most beautiful islands and inspired author James Michener's mythical Bal Hai in his 1958 musical "South Pacific". We breakfast on the island after which guests can snorkel on the Rengis coral garden or take a boat onto the main island for a jungle walk. Opportunities for scuba diving or snorkelling off the remote and rocky east coast precedes a short sail to Pulau Tulai or Coral Island where we anchor off Pasir Panjang Beach with its pure white soft sands and Batu Malang (Malang Rock) legendary for snorkelling. The vessel overnights in a peaceful bay.



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DAY 5; TIOMAN

Dallinghoo remains on Tioman, finding another picture postcard anchorage for the day, guests continue exploring the crystal waters, diverse reefs, and rain forests ashore on the island Tioman. For the adventurous diver there are several excellent deep dives on the smaller outlying islands and underwater seamounts.



DAY 6: PULAU SEMBILANG

A leisurely start to the day with a final walk on the beach or a swim then Dallinghoo will depart from Pulau Tioman for the 2 hour sail to Pulau Sembilang, a lovely little island giving its name to this captivating archipelago. Close by are a series of small islands, mostly uninhabited with stunning snorkelling in crystal clear waters and lovely white coral sand beaches. We sail between the islands and anchor overnight to witness a fabulous sunset and the clouds capping the mountains of the Malaysian mainland.



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DAY 7: PULAU BABI BASAR

Rise & shine late, take another leisurely morning in the beautiful anchorage at Pulau Sembilang and after the mornings activities weigh anchor and take the two hour sail to Palau Babi Basar.

Here you will be greeted by another group of stunning islands and with aqua blue sea, powder white sands and Dallinghoo will anchor in a perfect spot. After lunch on board snorkel on reef and return to the yacht for your final sun set and dinner.



DAY 8: PULAU SIBU

Say good-bye to Babi Basar after breakfast and take the short sail back to Palau Sibul where the adventure started 7 days earlier. Anchor and a final swim before lunch, say good bye and board the speed boat back to Tanjung Leman Jetty where your taxi will return you to Singapore.
