

7-Nights / 8-Days Langkawi to Phuket Itinerary



This 7 night and 8 day itinerary takes you from Malaysia tourist island of Langkawi through the southern Thai islands of th Andaman Sea and onto the Thai tourist island of Phuket, along the way Dallinghoo will stop off on some of the less know islands in Thailand off the beaten track where you can still find the picture postcard scenes away from the crowds., swim in emerald sea and leave your foot prints in the sand on beaches with no other.

This cruise will not just sea, sand and isolated islands we will also be stopping off on the tourist islands of Koh Lipe and Koh Phi Phi – both famous for their low key and laid back atmosphere. Many puritans will claim that Koh Phi Phi has now been spoiled by the numbers going to the island and that Koh Lipe is now the island of choice – your will hear often "Koh Lipe is the new Phi Phi".







Day 1: Telaga Harbour to Koh Lipe

Guest's will be met at Langkawi's International Airport and brought to Talaga Harbour only 10 minutes away. After the welcome aboard Schooner Dallinghoo the Captain will conduct the safety briefing, once the captain has completed all immigration procedures you will depart port and cruise out for the 3 hour cruise to Koh Lipe where you can have your first swim in the Andaman Sea before enjoy a sunset cocktail and a first dinner on board. The evening can be spent ashore in the small rustic town of Lipe.

Day 2: Koh Lipe to Koh Bulon Lae

Breakfast on board; you will get the chance for a last run ashore and walk through Koh Lipe's "town' it's one street for any last minute shopping and the last for a few days! Once back on board Dallinghoo will sail mid-morning to Koh Bulon Lae a small island in a group of islands where Dallinghoo will find a suitable anchorage for the afternoon and evening. Koh Bulon Lae is the main island in the group and has a couple of low key resorts on it, the other islands are uninhabited. He you can swim and relax for the afternoon and explore ashore.





Day 3: Koh Bulon Lae to Koh Rok Nok

A dawn start for the crew departing Koh Bulon Lae for the 7 hour sail to Koh Rok Nok, guests will enjoy breakfast and lunch underway and Dallinghoo will arrive at the Koh Rok Nok anchorage early afternoon. Another National Park and actually a pair of islands with a narrow channel between them, swimming and snorkeling here some of the best in the region. Access to the beach here is easy with a small jetty and park ranger station on the island, a few day tripper boats arrive in the morning and head off in mid-afternoon and then the islands is all yours!



Day 4: Koh Rok Nok to Koh Muk

An slow start to the day with breakfast at anchor and perhaps and early morning swim before the short sail to Koh Muk, arriving here for lunch. Though a pretty island with a few nice beaches and a low key resort Koh Muk is famous for it's Emerald Cave. Though can be a little busy in the mornings with day trippers by mid-afternoon these have left and the cave is your own. This is a 'must do' experience and one that you will remember for the rest of your life!







Day 5: Koh Muk to Koh Haa Yai

After a relaxed breakfast Dallinghoo will weigh anchor and short sail to the island of Koh Haa Yai, actually a small group of five islets jutting out in the middle of sea. These islets only have one small beach but the water is crystal clear, Dallinghoo will anchor for your lunch and then you can spend the afternoon relaxing and swimming or snorkeling. This is a popular diving location for beginners or experts and can be visited by dive boats from Koh Lanta however these generally return in the afternoon and the islands and sunset is yours to enjoy.



Day 6: Koh Haa Yai to Koh Lanta

Another easy start with breakfast at anchor and that swim in the perfect sea before Dallinghoo lifts her anchor mid-morning for the short sail over to Koh Lanta. Arrive here and anchored in early afternoon guests can relax on board or take an excursion ashore. Koh Lanta is one of the large islands on this trip with a small town and a number for beach resorts.





Day 7: Koh Lanta to Koh Phi Phi

Dallinghoo will lift her anchor after breakfast for the cruise over the Island of Koh Phi Phi, this is one of the more famous Thai islands and the small tourist town is busy with the bars and restaurants and all the usual tourist items, at night it is lively with its entertainment. Dallinghoo will anchor off so that guests can get ashore during the day and evening or just chill out on board!

Day 8: Koh Phi Phi to Chalong, Phuket

Your final day will be a morning sail from Phi Phi to Chalong on the island of Phuket arriving in early afternoon and after your luch on board you will dis-embark here at the jetty, where you can start your Phuket adventure or head to the airport for the flight out.
